HOW TO USE THESE CARDS

The flow

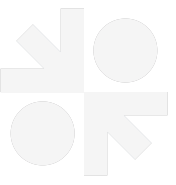
These cards follow the Resolution Ready theory of change.
Listen: gather information. What do we know?
Reflect: think deeper. What is really going on?
Structure: plan. What needs to happen?
Respond: act. How do we move forward?
Connect: support. What do we need from each other?
Wild cards: change pace or challenge the room.

Getting started

Choose cards that fit your session and your challenge.
Read the question aloud to the group.
Give people time to think before responding.

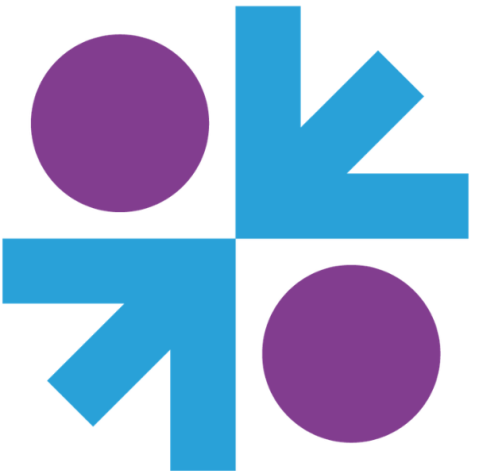
Listen

Reflect

Understand the issue with clarity and care



Structure

Bring tools and frameworks that support better decisions



Respond

Support action that is timely, fair and confident

What is the hardest truth
this group needs to face?

What are the barriers and which ones can we remove?

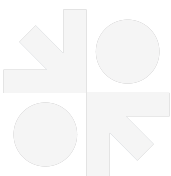
What is the first thing we
